

2022 RATIFICATIONINFO CONTRACT HIGHLIGHTS

- Across-the-Board Wage Increases: Pay increases of 7% in 2022, 5% in 2023 and 5% in 2024
- **Ratification/Lump-Sum Bonus:** \$3,000 for 0.5 1.0 FTE employees, \$1,500 for 0 0.49 FTE employees
- **Longevity Increase:** Employees eligible for longevity rate after serving five years in the same classification at the top of the pay scale, even if those years are not consecutive
- **Hardship Fund:** \$100,000 per year for union to provide relief to employees for needs related to food, transportation and housing insecurity, plus \$100,000 per year for assistance with child-care insecurity
- **Differentials:** Increased weekend differential: \$1.50/hour; new additional-need incentive: 30% or \$10.00/hour, whichever is greater; new float-pool differential: \$1.00/hour; expanded preceptor-pay eligibility
- Bereavement Leave: 20 hours of paid bereavement leave per year
- Well-being Leave: New bank of paid hours (8 per year, capped at 24 hours)
- Other Leave: Expanded paid test/interview leave; expanded paid leave for pre-retirement counseling; new catastrophic event/emergency leave
- **TriMet Pass:** First TriMet pass for new employees will now be offered at \$25.00 (other passes continue to cost only \$50.00)
- **Promotions/Reclassifications:** Employees will retain original anniversary date when promoted or upwardly reclassified, so progression increases won't be adversely affected
- Education & Training Hours: Guaranteed 24 hours of job-related training
- **DEI and Anti-Discrimination Language:** New definitions; clearer process to handle complaints of discrimination and harassment; quarterly reporting on these cases
- **Medical Monitoring:** Pilot program to provide a comprehensive metabolic panel, complete blood count and urinalysis for medical monitoring of pharmacists and pharmacy techs who compound hazardous drugs
- **Exit Interviews:** OHSU will begin offering exit interviews to bargaining-unit employees
- **Bargaining Dates:** Negotiations will begin one month earlier; first mediation session will be held one week earlier
